DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

- ✓ Not a private issue
- ✓ Law 3500/2006
- ✓ Constitutes a presumption of intolerability of living together

Family members:

- Spouses or parents or of 1st and 2nd degree relatives and their children
- ▶ If co-habiting, relatives of 3rd and 4th degree
- Any minor co-habiting with the family
- Partners and their children (common or not), if co-habiting
- Former spouses

Common penal law applies

- In case of former partner (not spouse)
- In case of same-sex partners

Stricter sentences

- When the victim is a pregnant women
- Victim unable to resist
- In front of a minor

Criminal behaviour

- ✓bodily injure (article 6)
- ✓unlawful threat, fear or anxiety with the threat of violence or other wrongful act (art. 7)
- ✓Rape and insult of sexual dignity by humiliating words or actions (incl. inside marriage) (art. 9)
- *ex officio persecuted, no fees

Penal Arbitration

Absconding from persecution if both parties agree.

Residence Permit on humanitarian grounds,

victims of domestic violence

Art. 19A L. 4375/2016:

Victims of THB

- Identification from Prosecutor
- Residence Permit
- Special PoliceDepartment

- Underreporting
- Lack of integration
- No durable safety
- No referral pathways (esp. to legal aid services)
